Importantly, **I am very keen to have the books and companion electronic resources widely used in helping teachers and students achieve better outcomes in their teaching and learning of economics.** They are full colour, with every chart and model accompanied by a video explanation from me, there are simulators and QR code resources galore – not just the dashboard but every single graph and every single calculation throughout the HSC and prelim courses. There are interactives for the students to practice with (flashcards) and a digital workbook with HSC quality multiple choice and short answer questions for each topic. I would be delighted to visit with you and your school to explain how they can make a real difference as prescribed resources for your classes – just drop me an email. I wrote and created them out of dissatisfaction with the other offerings and included within them a very, very wide and diverse range of teaching and learning resources that I wanted to use in my teaching. The Prelim 2024 book also includes further additional teacher only resources where used as class sets, with video thoughts from me on how to teach different content, and a suite of powerpoint slides and other documents for teaching.
